MIAMI BEACH PRIDE 2021

According to The Encyclopedia of Lesbian and Gay Histories and Cultures, "The first organized gay pride week was celebrated in Miami Beach in early 1972 with a march on Lincoln Road protesting a city law banning cross-dressing." Gay Pride has become an international celebration of gay cultures and Pride Festivals around the world boasting rosters of star-studded events, performances, and parades. LGBT+ travelers often choose to visit cities during Pride celebrations to bond with like-minded people. COVID has affected the world and Gay Pride celebrations have been canceled or postponed in cities around the globe.

This year, Miami Beach Pride returns with an impressive roster of events making it one of the most diverse and colorful Pride celebrations in the world. After last year's cancellation due to COVID-19, this year's party, usually set in April, will take place on the weekend of September 18-19 with events starting on September 10. The Sunday parade running along the iconic Ocean Drive returns along with a COVID compliant festival located on the sands of Lummus Park.

Miami Beach became a gay mecca in the '80s and '90s but it wasn't until April 2009 that a city-sanctioned Gay Pride Parade was organized. Miami Beach Gay Pride Festival first event only attracted a crowd of 15,000 people whereas the 2019 festival attracted over 140,000 people. The event has become a highlight of the Miami Beach calendar making organizers proud.





"As the founding executive director of Miami Beach Pride, it gives me great joy to see what it has become," says Cindy Brown now Senior Program Manager at Lambda Living. "Pride is one of the only places where all aspects of the LGBTQ+ community can gather in one place. It is vital for a thriving LGBTQ+ community to have these types of opportunities. Having LGBTQ+ youth and seniors in the same venue helps to create an environment where we can see one another, and how far we have come."

Pride attracts visitors from all over the world, however this year the U.S. travel ban may have some effect on the festival attendees. Many feel that this year's festival is important to bring people the community together. "There has never been a moment in my lifetime when community was so important," says David Sexton, Miami Beach artist and activist. "We have struggled through the past few years and we are going to get through it TOGETHER! Celebrate your Pod, your People, your Pride!"

"Miami Beach Pride is a time to honor how far we've come as a community— but also how much further we still need to go," adds Michael Gongora, Miami Beach's first openly gay elected commissioner.

"It's important for us to celebrate being able to live freely and love who we love; it's also a reminder that we must continue to support each other and work towards equal rights in employment and housing at the state and federal levels. Love is love."

George Neary, former President of Cultural Tourism and LGBT Marketing for the Greater Miami Convention and Visitors Bureau and one of Miami Beach's most visible promoters also emphasizes the importance of Miami Beach Pride for the community and hopes all will participate. "The Miami Beach Pride parade is only one aspect of this week long amazing community event and has always been the Exclamation point of a distinctive pride week of events," states Neary. 

PROPOSED MIAMI BEACH LAW TO BAN ALCOHOL SALES PAST 2AM, DRAWS CRITICISM, CONCERNS

City Commissioners voted to place a referendum on the November 2nd ballot that will ask voters whether the city should roll back alcohol sales and consumption from 5 a.m. to 2 a.m. across all hotels, bars and businesses in Miami Beach.

In 2017, a similar alcohol ban was proposed and Miami Beach voters rejected it at an almost 2 to 1 margin, but according to Miami Beach Mayor Dan Gelber, the alcohol ban is part of his 12-point plan to reduce crime.

However, elected officials and members of the community point out that the alcohol ban the city issued in 2020 to address the pandemic actually increased crime, and they are arguing that the alcohol ban is an effective way to reduce crime, and if it causes more harm than good.

State Representative Michael Grieco (D-Miami Beach), who opposes the 2 AM Ban, claims the proposal does nothing to address the violent crime in Miami Beach.

"The proposed 2 a.m. alcohol ban for Miami Beach is nothing more than a recycled red herring, a distraction that City Hall wants to throw at you instead of taking some initiative to fix the real problem," Grieco said. Instead, Grieco believes a better solution is to invest in a stronger police presence in the area. "To start, the city can enforce the laws that already exist and they can do so by getting our law enforcement out into the community. That means getting our officers out of their cars, and on bikes and ATVs, so they have a more physical and visible presence within our community," said Grieco.

Miami Beach residents are echoing these concerns.

"The 2 a.m. alcohol ban isn't going to fight crime. Closing hotels and clubs at 2 a.m. is going to increase the illegal late-night AirBNB house parties in my neighborhood," said Miami Beach resident Viarda Besu.



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"Our city officials need to realize that the only way to fight crime is by taking the issue head on with visible policing, enforcement of existing laws and investing to clean up our streets and our communities," continued Besu.

Miami Beach is projected to lose as estimated \$40 million a year in revenue if the 2 a.m. alcohol ban passes. A budget gap of this magnitude could cause a domino effect, leading to big increases in property taxes, reductions in city services, a decrease in home values, and more crime.

The proposal is also drawing criticism over language that specifically allows for "exceptions...by the City Commission," to permit businesses, at the Commission's discretion, to receive special waivers to keep their bars open until 5 a.m.

"I've read the fine print. The 2 a.m. alcohol ban will give city politicians the power to dole out exemptions to their political donors and business owners who are insiders," said local business owner Pablo Martinez. "That seems unfair for those of us running honest locally-owned restaurants and bars."

Early voting in Miami Beach begins beings Monday, October 18 through Sunday, October 31 and Election Day is Tuesday, November 2.

MIAMI BEACH HAS \$1.5 FOR NEW EVENTS.



In an effort to promote local programming that generates community engagement, Miami Beach will provide up to \$1.5 Million in special events sponsorship for events that take place over the next couple of years. Mayor Dan Gelber who wants to promote the City as a "world-class tourist and event destination" and pushed for the funding, said, "We recognize the potential role these funds will play in encouraging tourism and economic development."

Applications for sponsorships will be taken in two windows. The first is open now through October 30, 2021 for events that take place between January 1, 2022 and September 30, 2022.

The second application period will be between January 1, 2022 and February 28, 2022 for events planned October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

Sponsorship requests will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

Unique and engaging events that improve the quality of life for residents.

Events that increase tourism through group hotel sales and attendance.

Accessibility for the general public.

Events that contribute to the reputation of Miami Beach as a national and international destination.

Events that enhance Miami Beach's reputation as a cultural destination.

The City emphasizes, "Special consideration will be given to events that enhance Miami Beach's reputation as a place to visit, live or work and events that celebrate Miami Beach's rich heritage and beauty."







OCEAN TERRACE RECEIVES THE GREEN LIGHT!

The City of Miami Beach Historic Preservation Board approved the Ocean Terrace Holdings (OTH) redevelopment plan and Ocean Terrace streetscape masterplan. Led by OTH principals Sandor Scher and Alex Blavatnik, the redevelopment plan includes a 20-story, 75-unit residential building, new restaurant and retail options, and a 127-room hotel that incorporates the carefully renovated and unified historic Broadmoor and Ocean Surf properties. Following years of community outreach and negotiations with the City, the approval of OTH's redevelopment plan will revitalize this underutilized area in North Beach along Collins Avenue, between 74th and 75th Street.

"The approved plan for Ocean Terrace is more economically viable, will attract a world-class hotel operator, and will incorporate a beautifully-designed oceanfront greenspace for the entire community to enjoy," said Sandor Scher, principal of Ocean Terrace Holdings, LLC. "We look forward to getting to work on our long-awaited project, which will restore the street-level historic architecture, transform Ocean Terrace into a lushly-landscaped oasis and give new life to this cherished beachfront."

The approved plan includes a few recently added enhancements that will elevate the project's hotel and residential components. To help attract a world-class hotel flag to the project, the plan adds a new hotel building with 72 rooms that will be built within previously approved height restrictions. The hotel will be managed as one operation with the historic Broadmoor and Ocean Surf hotel buildings. The hotel will include restaurants, bar, meeting rooms, fitness, spa, outdoor pool and deck, rooftop lounge, and on-site parking.

With an historically inspired design, the residential component will feature curvilinear designs reflective of MiMo style, such as curved balconies and eyebrows. Units will range in size from 2 to 5 bedrooms and feature a full complement of luxury amenities. The masterplan also calls for approximately 15,000 square feet of commercial space along Collins Avenue and approximately 3,000 square feet along Ocean Terrace.

"We are grateful to the North Beach community and City of Miami Beach for working together with us to create a vision for Ocean Terrace that incorporates historic preservation, activation of the oceanfront, and economic revitalization," said Alex Blavatnik, principal of Ocean Terrace Holdings, LLC. "We are excited to now be able to bring that vision to life, starting with an iconic and activated public space that will belong to the City for future generations."

The first stage of the redevelopment plan will focus on a new \$15 million, five-acre public green space along Ocean Terrace designed by world-renowned landscape architect Raymond Jungles. The asphalt street will be converted into an active, pedestrian-focused greenspace with native trees that will provide much-needed shade. A public-private partnership with the City of Miami Beach, the streetscape plan will also offer new walking trails, water features, public seating, and a covered pavilion. A mid-block open breezeway in the Ocean Terrace development will also connect Collins Avenue retail to Ocean Terrace, allowing enhanced public access to the oceanfront. OTH will fully fund the park, with no cost to taxpayers, and will deliver the greenspace on an expedited timeline.

Construction on the public greenspace is set to begin in the third quarter 2022. Pre-construction sales for the residential building are also estimated to launch in 2022.



Felix: Well I was about 19yrs old and a friend of mine Richie Santelises who went on to work fo Ocean Drive Magazine, was Interning at Hot 105 back in 84 it was a dance station, he submitted a Mixtage that I did along with my best friend Mix Magician AD, it got into the hands of head Mixer Phil jones, he loved the mix and invited us in for a guest spot which turned into a regular Mix Show shift, I did 5 years there, then 12 years at power 96 and did the rest of my Radio time at 939 MIA and Mia 921 with I heart radio, I officially retired from Radio in April 2019, it just wasn't challenging anymore and decided to start my own podcast show Sama Sutra and focus on my other business ventures, Dj Sama Ent and the Pro Am Dance and Dj Expo, I know I made the right decision because I wake up everyday feeling blessed and grateful.

MBLM: Who do you look up to in the music/dj industry and why?



First, we were offered what was probably the best tasting sake that I have ever had. Not hot sake, but delicious room temperature sake with a hint of tropical fruit. Since it was my wife's and my first time at Kaori, we let our waitress handle the order. Our first course was fresh, very fresh plate of over 5 soft and tasty mushrooms that was accompanied by creamy light cream dipping sauce, INCREDIBLE. Since my wife is vegetarian and I am "sometimes vegetarian" I decided to try some fish, and there's no better fish than fresh, grilled and lightly flavored octopus. Was by far the best octopus I have ever had, soft, tasty and it literally melted in my mouth.

Kaori also has a unique wine and cocktail menu that's made up of local Japanese favorites and local beers. My wife also ordered the fresh veggie and hummus plate along with the quinoa platter on top of a creamy and very addictive avocado spread. After being spoiled for about 2 hours we decided to leave room for the dessert, and dam I'm glad I did. I'm not much of a dessert guy (cause I always have drinks with my meals and sweet and liquor don't mix well with me). but the Dark chocolate fountain cake toped with dark chocolate syrup and the mango cheesecake on top of a sweet jelly spread was to die for. Kaori Brickell may not be your every weekend spot, but it should be your "I'm going to spoil myself" spot, trust me, place is incredible...








