





MARIO KNAPP: WHO HE IS & WHY HE'S RUNNING FOR SHERIFF

Major Mario Knapp (Ret.) is a 27-year veteran of the Miami-Dade Police Department, a native Miamian, a son of a single mother who immigrated to the U.S. in pursuit of the American Dream, a father of 2, and a candidate to be the next Sheriff of Miami-Dade County. A graduate of Coral Gables Senior High School, Mario has lived, worked, and raised his family in Miami-Dade for the vast majority of his life.

Mario Knapp's journey in law enforcement is both broad and deep, starting at the young age of 20 years old, and eventually having served in every civil service rank within the MDPD. From walking the beat as a patrol officer to navigating the complexities of operational assignments within public housing, narcotics, SWAT, and robbery intervention operations, Knapp has been at the forefront of addressing some of the most critical challenges facing the community. Even when assigned to non-operational roles, administrative roles, his tenure includes roles that demanded not only bravery and action but thoughtful leadership and strategy, such as serving as a commander in the robbery intervention section, overseeing departmental training as a captain, and serving as the Use of Force Expert for Miami-Dade County for nearly 2 decades. Knapp's experience is marked by a hands-on approach to crime-fighting and community engagement, making him a familiar face to many within Miami-Dade County. His work in independently recognizing the need to establish a committee for the purposes of developing the mass casualty attack protocols showcases his foresight and commitment to public safety at the highest levels. This committee was formulated weeks before the Marjory Stoneman Douglas shooting. When tragedy struck Miami-Dade in summer of 2021, Knapp stepped up to the challenge and served as the Command Post Incident Commander at the Surfside Building Collapse.

As a father raising his kids in this community, and as a resident of Miami-Dade for over 4 decades, Mario Knapp feels that this election for Sheriff is one of the most crucial elections of our lifetimes. For that reason, in June of 2023, he launched his campaign to be the next Sheriff of Miami-Dade County with a primary focus: taking politics out of policing so that Miami-Dade can be the safest and best place to live, work, and raise a family. His platform includes forming a section in the Sheriff's Office to combat HOA Fraud, strengthening and expanding the public corruption unit, putting more officers on the streets of Miami-Dade to ensure the safety of every resident of Miami-Dade no matter what community they live in, and making sure the Sheriff's Office is accountable to the people of Miami-Dade, not the politicians.

As Sheriff, Knapp will institute policies that allow for better policing of the community, more support for our officers, and increased safety for the residents of Miami-Dade. His commitment to transparency, integrity, and accountability will not waver. However, he cannot win this race alone. QUEEN OF THE SUNRISE

Brigitte Grosjean is known as the "Queen of the Sunrise," thanks to the acclaim for the stunning photos she has posted daily over the past six years. At last count, she is closing in on 2,200 sunrises, and still counting.

Recently, the City of Miami Beach honored Grosjean with a proclamation, and dedicated a special day for her, in gratitude for her "unwavering commitment to capturing the beauty of Miami Beach mornings."

"I thought to myself, 'How lovely is this. Sunrises signify hope, and a feeling of what could be," says Miami Beach Commissioner Kristen Rosen Gonzalez, who selected Grosjean for the honor. Also, on June 21, a display of Grosjean's sunrise photographs, projected on a giant monitors, and also on smaller monitors ,which were placed around the Miami Beach Bandshell, as part of the evening's Summer Solstice Celebration at the Miami Beach Bandshell.

I reached out to her because I realized that her sunrises would be a perfect way to accompany our Summer Solstice celebration.



"Grosjean arises each morning before dawn, to position herself for the sunrise, and commits about 30 minutes to getting exactly the right show. She takes the photos from her small backyard where she lives, off of Biscayne Boulevard in Miami. It is an unassuming plot of land, but boasts the proverbial "Million Dollar View," because it looks directly to on Miami Beach's famed skyline, directly across Biscayne Bay.

Grosjean, was born in England, but arrived here 25 years ago, through a circuitous—and very glittery – route. She chanced upon her first calling as an agent for models and actors after finishing school. "It was the swinging 1960s. I met the famous designer Martha Hill, who told me I could become a model agent in Paris, and it was there that I learned the movie side of the business. I also spoke Italian, so I took care of models in Milan." She had a delightful time, hopscotching through Milan, Rome, Paris, and London, representing models and celebrities. Along the way, she becoming friends with celebrities including Italian movie director Carlo Ponti, David Bowie and Iggy Pop. Then, she moved to New York, where she got into the public relations business, launching the famous beauty salon "Stella." She worked with them for several years, until she was picked to launch their business in Miami Beach. She fell in love with Miami Beach, and stayed on to work in promotion and public relations. She also went staff when she was chosen to oversee the transformation Miami's Parrot Jungle, to help oversee there transformation into what is known now as Jungle Island. It was a job that involved her in working with the animals there, which, as a longtime animal lover, she also adored." Nowadays, with nine-to-five work behind her, Grosjean spends her days bicycling around her neighborhood, photographing her favorite subjects, including animals, flowers and -of course-those sunrises. She also looks after her own dogs, as well as keeping an eye on all the dogs and cats on in her neighborhood.

She wakens each day about 6 a.m. and heads to her backyard, once for a quick peek at the sky, then goes out again about 10 minutes later, to see how the colors are shaping up.She peers at the sky with the eye of an artist. "If there is going to be clouds, then I'll add an accessory – a dog, a gate, a tree, a boat, or a banana tree, because I don't want to bore people," she says, adding, "I want every morning to be a surprise."

As for Grosjean, she is thrilled to be acknowledged for doing something she started doing almost accidentally, but that turned a day brightener that her fans on social media look for every day. "At this stage in my life, I am delighted to have another hurrah, and it is for bringing people beauty, joy and peace. I thank God that I have an eye for beauty, because I love nature, and nature is life to me." I was raised by a single Mother who worked extremely hard to give me and my two sisters everything we needed, however, the circumstances and upbringing were hard! During this time, Miami Beach and South Florida in general were known for violence, gangs, and drugs – we actually lived smack in the middle of the cocaine & crack epidemic. We were always broke (but not broken) and at times we didn't have enough food to eat. I also remember moving around a lot – to be fully transparent, I pretty much lived in and out of hotels between the ages of 4-14. I can tell you stories about going to sleep hungry or being evicted and packing up our things in the middle of the night. I can also tell you about free school lunches, my family not having a car and catching the metro bus everywhere, and even worse, seeing my classmates and friends getting killed and going to jail/prison. One memory that always stands out is going grocery shopping and watching my mom use paper money that looked different from the money others in line were using, I remember her telling me that the government gives us food stamps so we could eat, this was my life!

As I grew older it became clear to me....we were poor! Eventually, we moved to the other side of the Beach to 71st Street, which is a whole other story for another time. For the record, I don't regret how I was raised. Growing up in poverty taught me empathy and perseverance and I always believed in myself and my abilities. My mother is an incredible woman, she taught me how to love and instilled in me the pride to believe in myself. Being poor doesn't make anyone less than someone else and having money doesn't make anyone better. I am proud to be who I am and proud of where I'm from.

You have a podcast show, Miami Spotlight Show, how did you get into it?

Yes, the Miami Spotlight Show, it's a Podcast that was born in 2018 right here in The305. I've been interviewing people for the past 22 years and have always been fascinated with hearing people's stories. Ultimately, I wanted to create a platform to shine a spotlight on the heavy-hitters making a positive impact in the South Florida Community, so I figured what better way than a Podcast. The show provides a platform for entrepreneurs, musicians, athletes, celebrities, artists and creatives to speak about their journey, success, ventures, partnerships and projects. We just Inked a new blockbuster distribution deal through reVolver Podcasts and iHeart Radio and the show will be syndicated across all platforms, that includes a full slate of programming. *"We took a long break, but it's time to bring the show back to the South Florida community. We're ready to create magnificent content and impactful interviews. It's incredible to look back at where we started in 2018 and to know that we still have the best fans in the game! The Miami Spotlight Show will continue to be informative, entertaining, and above all, authentic".*

Who is the most famous person you've interviewed? All of the guests we have on our show are famous in their own way, we enjoy speaking to all of them...they're all amazing people!

Do you make a living with the show? If not, what's your day job? We have some pretty cool sponsors and investors on the team...and we're always looking for more! The Miami Spotlight Show is my passion project! I have full autonomy and creative control to record shows. At this stage of the game, I much rather knock out quality interviews 2x a month rather than having random people on the show just for likes/views. I've been in Talent Acquisition/Casting/Recruitment since 2001 (do the math) and the bulk of that experience has been in the Media, Advertising and Entertainment Industries. I'm currently managing the TA Recruitment function for one of the best Advertising Agencies on the planet, Zimmerman Advertising. You've probably seen the building with the big red Z while driving down I-95.



How has Miami Beach changed in the past 30 years? Wow, now that's loaded question! Okay, I'll put it this way, when I grew up on the Beach, Ocean Drive was like an alley - zero traffic with nothing but elderly retirees sunbathing, true story! I've seen Miami Beach transform into Art Deco and become the epicenter for Entertainment, Arts and the Fashion Industries. It's become home to many athletes, musicians and celebrities of all genres and it's considered as the most beautiful place on earth – a true world-class mega destination! Everyone knows this city was partly built by a massive infusion of investment capital that produced a reborn Miami Beach in the late 80's / early 90's, if you know you know! We call it the Scarface era, another true story!

Where do you see yourself in 10 years? That's a great question....they say you can't really know where you are going until you know where you have been. In my lifetime, I've owned and operated a record label (shameless plug FOE Records) that eventually landed me a deal with ROC Nation. I started a clothing line called 7One Clothing and I even dabbled in some real estate and made some really cool investments along the way. I don't know what the future holds, and I especially don't know how things will be in 10yrs. My only hope is that I'm healthy and happy and I continue to strive to be the best version of myself and be a good example that my wife, my mother and my entire family can be proud of! That's my definition of success!




