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MARIO KNAPP: WHO HE IS & WHY HE'S RUNNING FOR SHERIFF

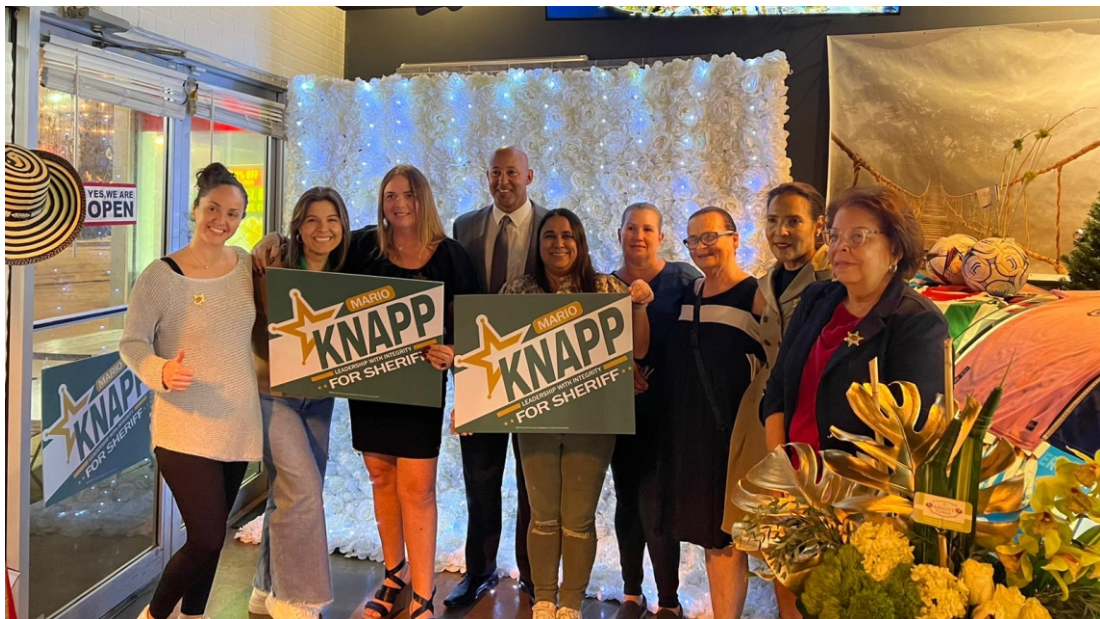
Major Mario Knapp (Ret.) is a 27-year veteran of the Miami-Dade Police Department, a native Miamian, a son of a single mother who immigrated to the U.S. in pursuit of the American Dream, a father of 2, and a candidate to be the next Sheriff of Miami-Dade County. A graduate of Coral Gables Senior High School, Mario has lived, worked, and raised his family in Miami-Dade for the vast majority of his life.

Mario Knapp's journey in law enforcement is both broad and deep, starting at the young age of 20 years old, and eventually having served in every civil service rank within the MDPD. From walking the beat as a patrol officer to navigating the complexities of operational assignments within public housing, narcotics, SWAT, and robbery intervention operations, Knapp has been at the forefront of addressing some of the most critical challenges facing the community. Even when assigned to non-operational roles, administrative roles, his tenure includes roles that demanded not only bravery and action but thoughtful leadership and strategy, such as serving as a commander in the robbery intervention section, overseeing departmental training as a captain, and serving as the Use of Force Expert for Miami-Dade County for nearly 2 decades. Knapp's experience is marked by a hands-on approach to crime-fighting and community engagement, making him a familiar face to many within Miami-Dade County. His work in independently recognizing the need to establish a committee for the purposes of developing the mass casualty attack protocols showcases his foresight and commitment to public safety at the highest levels. This committee was formulated weeks before the Marjory Stoneman Douglas shooting. When tragedy struck Miami-Dade in summer of 2021, Knapp stepped up to the challenge and served as the Command Post Incident Commander at the Surfside Building Collapse.

As a father raising his kids in this community, and as a resident of Miami-Dade for over 4 decades, Mario Knapp feels that this election for Sheriff is one of the most crucial elections of our lifetimes.

For that reason, in June of 2023, he launched his campaign to be the next Sheriff of Miami-Dade County with a primary focus: taking politics out of policing so that Miami-Dade can be the safest and best place to live, work, and raise a family. His platform includes forming a section in the Sheriff's Office to combat HOA Fraud, strengthening and expanding the public corruption unit, putting more officers on the streets of Miami-Dade to ensure the safety of every resident of Miami-Dade no matter what community they live in, and making sure the Sheriff's Office is accountable to the people of Miami-Dade, not the politicians.

As Sheriff, Knapp will institute policies that allow for better policing of the community, more support for our officers, and increased safety for the residents of Miami-Dade. “Grosjean arises each morning before dawn, to position herself for the sunrise, and commits about 30 minutes to getting exactly the right show. She takes the photos from her small backyard where she lives, off of Biscayne Boulevard in Miami. It is an unassuming plot of land, but boasts the proverbial “Million Dollar View,” because it looks directly to on Miami Beach's famed skyline, directly across Biscayne Bay.

Grosjean, was born in England, but arrived here 25 years ago, through a circuitous—and very glittery – route. She chanced upon her first calling as an agent for models and actors after finishing school.

“It was the swinging 1960s. I met the famous designer Martha Hill, who told me I could become a model agent in Paris, and it was there that I learned the movie side of the business. I also spoke Italian, so I took care of models in Milan.” She had a delightful time, hopscotching through Milan, Rome, Paris, and London, representing models and celebrities. Along the way, she becoming friends with celebrities including Italian movie director Carlo Ponti, David Bowie and Iggy Pop. Then, she moved to New York, where she got into the public relations business, launching the famous beauty salon “Stella.”

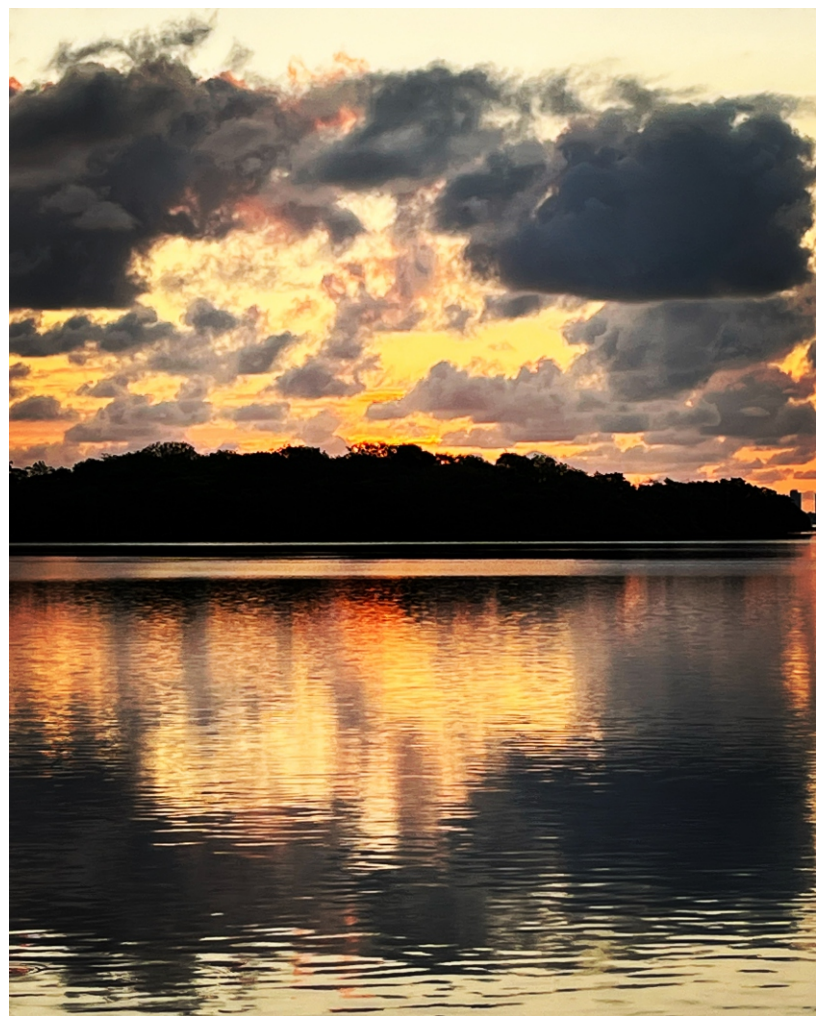
She worked with them for several years, until she was picked to launch their business in Miami Beach. She fell in love with Miami Beach, and stayed on to work in promotion and public relations. It was a job that involved her in working with the animals there, which, as a longtime animal lover, she also adored.”

Nowadays, with nine-to-five work behind her, Grosjean spends her days bicycling around her neighborhood, photographing her favorite subjects, including animals, flowers and –of course—those sunrises. She also looks after her own dogs, as well as keeping an eye on all the dogs and cats on in her neighborhood.

There we would find a red door as mentioned in the letter, we knock three times a small window on the door opens they requested a passcode. We gave the passcode, suddenly the red door opened into a small speakeasy bar with four couples having drinks waiting for the food experience to start. After a drink, and mingling with the other customers, a double door opens into this large room with a very well lit dinner bar in the middle, with three chefs, greeting us with sake and drinks. That’s the exact moment I knew that this was going to be a once in a lifetime experience. The menu well, there was no menu. All we were told was that we were about to eat the most exclusive and exotic dishes in the world, and they weren’t exaggerating. The three chefs repaired and created every dish in front of us while giving us a short intro on the dish. We cannot mention one dish, why? most were very exotic fishes that weren’t from the region and were very rare and as I mentioned, there were no menus. After the 12 to 14 course dinner experience, we finished off the evening with some of the best coconut ice cream I have ever tasted. Let me warn you. This is not an inexpensive experience, and remember that this is not just dinner. This is the type of dinner that cost a little bit but you’ll remember the experience for the rest of your life, and not to mention we met some fascinating people at this dinner. If you can, I urge you to try this restaurant. It is a big winner for anyone trying to impress that special someone and for any type of occasion or holiday. I have never experienced this type of restaurant before, But I sure hope I will again, soon.

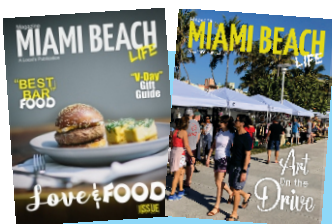

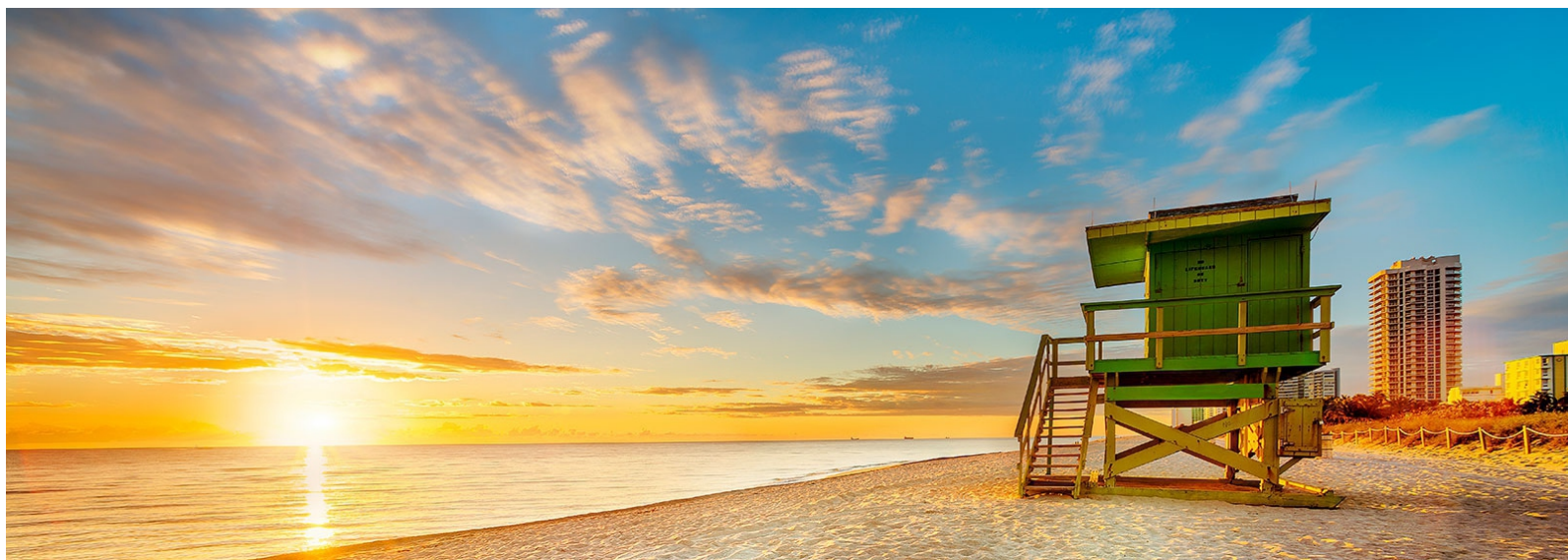

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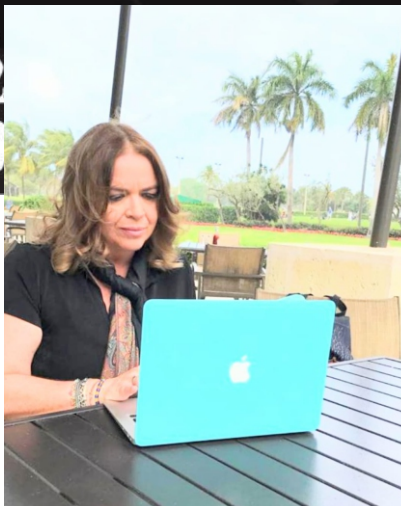
